ORDER DENYING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

On October 1, 2013, a Decision was rendered in Case No. H-5855 SAC revoking the real estate broker license of Respondent effective October 23, 2013, but granting Respondent the right to the issuance of a restricted real estate salesperson license subject to the provisions of Section 10156.7 of the Business and Professions Code (Code) of the State of California, and to enumerated additional terms, conditions and restrictions imposed under authority of Section 10156.6 of said Code. Among those terms, conditions and restrictions, the Order provided, "Respondent shall not be eligible to apply for the issuance of an unrestricted real estate license nor for the removal of any of the conditions, limitations or restrictions of a restricted license until two years have elapsed from the effective date of this Decision."

A restricted real estate salesperson license was issued to Respondent on October 23, 2013, and Respondent has operated as a restricted licensee since that time.

On November 4, 2014, Respondent petitioned for reinstatement of said real estate broker license, and the Attorney General of the State of California has been given notice of the filing of said petition.

Per the Decision of the Commissioner, Respondent is not eligible to apply for reinstatement until October 23, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's petition for reinstatement of Respondent's real estate broker license is denied.
