On or about August 10, 2020, in the United States District Court, Central District of California, case no. CR19-172-JFW, Respondent was convicted of violating 21 U.S.C. 841(a)(1) and 21 U.S.C. 841(b)(1)(C) (possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance, to wit: MDMA aka "ecstasy"), a felony. Respondent was sentenced, in part, to serve 36 months of probation, participate in an outpatient substance abuse treatment and counseling program, and pay a \$100 special assessment fee. The underlying facts of the conviction are on March 11, 2019, law enforcement found \$25,000 in cash and distribution quantities of various controlled substances in Respondent's bedrooom. Said crime bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

The crime of which Respondent was convicted as alleged above in Paragraph 2, above, constitutes cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under California Business and Professions Code sections 475(a)(2), 480(a), and 10177(b).
