23	the intention of the California Real Estate Commissioner ("Commissioner") to issue a Bar Order
24	pursuant to Section 10087(a) of the Code. Respondent failed to request a hearing in writing
25	within fifteen (15) days of service of the <i>Preliminary Bar Order and Notice of Intention to Issue</i>
26	Bar Order.
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1	Pursuant to the authority granted by Section 10087 of the Code, and after review
2	and consideration of the following facts, the Commissioner makes the following:
3	FINDINGS OF FACT
4	1. On or about November 14, 2011, in the Superior Court of the State of
5	California, County of Sacramento, Case No. 11F00941, Respondent was convicted of violating
6	Penal Code Sections 184(a)(1) (conspiracy), 524 (attempted extortion), 523 (threatening letters),
7	and two counts of Section 422 (terrorist threats), all felonies.
8	2. The felony convictions enumerated above bear a substantial relationship
9	under Section 2910, Title 10, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions, or
10	duties of a real estate licensee.
11	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
12	Based on the findings set forth above in paragraphs 1 and 2, the Commissioner
13	determines that you have been convicted of an offense reasonably related to the qualifications,
14	functions, or duties of a person engaged in the real estate business in accordance with the
15	provisions of this the Real Estate Law.
16	ORDER
17	NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to the authority of Section
18	10087 of the Code, that FRANK LIVINGSTON HICKS is hereby barred and prohibited for a
19	period of thirty-six (36) months from the effective date of this Bar Order, from engaging in any
20	of the following activities in the State of California:
21	(A) Holding any position of employment, management, or control in a real
22	estate business;
23	(B) Participating in any business activity of a real estate salesperson or a real
24	estate broker;
