PARKHURST, acting in her official capacity as a 16 Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, for Statement of Issues against 17 TAUSHA MARIE BALBIANI (herein "Respondent"), alleges as follows: 18 1. 19 On or about August 22, 2014, Respondent made application to the Bureau of 20 Real Estate of the State of California for a real estate salesperson license. 21 2. 22 On or about September 18, 2013, in the Superior Court of the State of California, 23 County of Sacramento, Case Number 13T02695, Respondent was convicted of violating section 24 23153(b) of the Vehicle Code (DUI causing bodily injury to another), a misdemeanor which 25 bears a substantial relationship under section 2910, title 10, California Code of Regulations, to 26 the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee. 27

Respondent's criminal conviction, as described above in Paragraph 2 constitutes grounds for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under sections 480(a) and 10177(b) of the Business and Professions Code.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that the above-entitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of a real estate salesperson license to Respondent, and for such other and further relief as may be proper in the premises.
