25	On or about December 24, 2014, in the Superior Court of the State of California,
26	County of Tehama, case number NCR-60884, Respondent was convicted of violating Section
27	10980(g)(2) of the California Welfare and Institutions Code (CalFresh or Supplemental Nutrition

1 Assistance Program Fraud), a misdemeanor which bears a substantial relationship under Section 2 2910, Title 10, of the California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of 3 a real estate licensee. 4 5 The facts alleged in Paragraph 3 constitute grounds under Sections 490 and 10177(b) of the Code for suspension or revocation of all licenses and license rights of 6 7 Respondent under Part 1 of Division 4 of the Code. 8 COST RECOVERY 9 5 10 Section 10106 of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the Bureau, the Commissioner may request the 11 12 Administrative Law Judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case. 13 14 WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations 15 of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all licenses and license rights of Respondent under the Code, for the cost of 16 investigation and enforcement as permitted by law, and for such other and further relief as may 17 18 be proper under the provisions of law. 19 20 Supervising Special Investigator 21 Dated at Sacramento, California, 22 23 **DISCOVERY DEMAND** 24 Pursuant to Sections 11507.6, et seq. of the Administrative Procedure Act, the Bureau of Real 25 Estate hereby makes demand for discovery pursuant to the guidelines set forth in the Administrative Procedure Act.
