Micholas 6 7 8 BEFORE THE BUREAU OF REAL ESTATE 9 STATE OF CALIFORNIA 10 11 In the Matter of the Application of No. H- 6366 SAC 12 SEAN ANDRE BEATTIE, STATEMENT OF ISSUES 13 Respondent. 14 The Complainant, TRICIA PARKHURST, in her official capacity as a 15 Supervising Special Investigator for the Bureau of Real Estate, State of California, brings this 16 Statement of Issues against SEAN ANDRE BEATTIE ("Respondent"), and is informed and 17 alleges as follows: 18 1 19 Respondent made application to the Bureau of Real Estate of the State of 20 California for a real estate broker license on or about September 15, 2014. 21 22 On or about June 3, 2003, in the United States District Court, Northern District of 23 California, Case No. CR00-0360-01 VRW, Respondent was convicted of violating 21 U.S.C. 24 Section 846 (conspiracy to distribute cocaine and to possess cocaine with intent to distribute), a 25 Class A felony, and 21 U.S.C. 841(a) and 841(b)(1)(A) and (B) (possession with intent to 26 distribute cocaine), a Class B felony, crimes that bear a substantial relationship under Section 27

2910, Title 10, of the California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

Respondent's criminal convictions, described in Paragraph 2, above, constitute cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate broker license pursuant to the provisions of Section 480(a) (criminal conviction) and 10177(b) (criminal conviction) of the California Business and Professions Code.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that the above-entitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a real estate broker license to Respondent, and for such other and further relief as may be proper under the provisions of the law.
