which is presently licensed as a corporate real estate broker. 1 2 4 3 Respondent is presently licensed and/or has license rights under the Code as a Mortgage Loan Originator Endorsement (MLO Endorsement). 4 5 5 6 On or about March 27, 2018, in the United States District Court, Eastern District of California, Case No. 2:15 cr-06234-4, Respondent was convicted of a violating 21 USC 7 Sections 841(a)(1) and 846 (conspiracy to manufacture (grow) marijuana), felonies and crimes 8 which bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, California Code of 9 Regulations, to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee. 10 11 6 The facts alleged in Paragraph 5, constitute cause under Section 10177(b) 12 (Conviction Of Crime Substantially Related To Qualifications, Functions Or Duties Of Real 13 14 Estate Licensee) and Section 490 (Conviction Substantially Related Crime) of the Code for suspension or revocation of Respondent's license under Real Estate Law. 15 16 7 The facts alleged in Paragraph 5, constitute cause for revocation of Respondent's 17 mortgage loan originator license endorsement under Sections 10166.05(b) (1) (felony conviction 18 within 7 years) and 10166.051(a) (suspend/revoke MLO Endorsement) of the Code. 19 20 8 21 Section 10106 of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the department, the commissioner may request 22 23 the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case. 24 WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations 25 of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary 26 27 action against all licenses and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of
