ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

On March 2, 2021, in Case No. H-6972 SAC, an Order was executed which accepted the petition for the voluntary surrender of the real estate salesperson license of Respondent. The Order became effective on April 15, 2021.

On April 1, 2025, Respondent petitioned for reinstatement of said real estate salesperson license, and the Attorney General of the State of California has been given notice of the filing of the petition.
