21	of Real Estate of the State of California (Department) for a real estate salesperson license.

23	On or about April 15, 2019, in the Superior Court of the State of California,
24	County of Napa, Case No. 19CR000115, Respondent was convicted of violating Section
25	23153(a) of the California Vehicle Code (driving under the influence of alcohol or a drug
26	causing death/bodily injury) and Section 23153(b) of the California Vehicle Code (driving under
27	the influence of alcohol with blood alcohol over .08 causing bodily injury), both felonies and

1	crimes which bear a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, California Code of
2	Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.
3	4
4	Respondent's criminal convictions, as described in Paragraph 3, above, constitute
5	cause for denial of his application for a real estate license under Sections 10177(b) (further
6	grounds for disciplinary action-conviction of crime) and 480(a) (conviction of crime) of the
7	Code.
8	WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that the above-entitled matter be set for
9	hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to
10	authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a real estate salesperson license to
11	Respondent and for such other and further relief as may be proper in the premises.
