# **DECISION**

This Decision is being issued in accordance with the provisions of Section 11520 of the Government Code, on evidence of compliance with Section 11505 of the Government Code and pursuant to the Order of Default filed on December 3, 2008, and the findings of fact set forth herein, which are based on one or more of the following: (1) Respondent's express admissions; (2) affidavits; and (3) other evidence.

This Decision revokes a real estate license on grounds of the conviction of a crime.

The right to reinstatement of a revoked real estate license is controlled by Section 11522 of the Government Code. A copy of Section 11522 and a copy of the Commissioner's <u>Criteria of Rehabilitation</u> are attached hereto for the information of Respondent.

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

1

On October 10, 2008, E.J. Haberer II made the Accusation in his official capacity as a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California. The Accusation, Statement to Respondent, and Notice of Defense were mailed, by certified and regular mail, to Respondent's last known mailing address on file with the Department on October 17, 2008.

On December 3, 2008, no Notice of Defense having been filed herein within the time prescribed by Section 11506 of the Government Code, Respondent's default was entered herein.

| | | | | | | | | At all times mentioned herein, Respondent has been licensed by the Department under the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code (hereinafter "Code") as a real estate salesperson

3.

On or about May 22, 2007, in the Santa Clara County Superior Court, Respondent was convicted of two violations of Section 14601.2 of the California Vehicle Code (knowingly driving on DUI conviction related suspended license), misdemeanors involving moral turpitude and crimes which are substantially related under Section 2910, Title 10, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

On or about June 12, 2008, in the Santa Clara County Superior Court, Respondent was convicted of a violation of Section 14601.2 of the California Vehicle Code (knowingly driving on DUI conviction related suspended license), a misdemeanor and a crime which is substantially related under Section 2910, Title 10, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

### DETERMINATION OF ISSUES

#### 1.

The findings above constitute cause for the suspension or revocation of the licenses and license rights of Respondent under Sections <u>490</u> and <u>10177(b)</u> of the Code.

2.

The standard of proof applied was clear and convincing proof to a reasonable certainty.

#### <u>ORDER</u>

<u>All licenses and licensing rights of Respondent EDDIE BURNIAS under the provisions of</u> <u>Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code are hereby revoked.</u>

At all times herein mentioned, from and after September 29, 2004, Respondent was and now is licensed by the Department of Real Estate (herein "Department") as a real estate salesperson.

IV

6 On or about May 22, 2007, in the Superior Court of 7 the State of California, County of Santa Clara, Respondent was 8 convicted of two counts of the crime of Driving with Suspended License in violation of Vehicle Code Section 14601.2(a), each a misdemeanor and a crime involving moral turpitude, which bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, California Code of Regulations, to the qualifications, functions, or duties 12 13 of a real estate licensee.

15 On or about June 12, 2008, in the Superior Court of 16 the State of California, County of Santa Clara, Respondent was 17 convicted of the crime of Driving with Suspended License in 18 violation of Vehicle Code Section 14601.1(a), a misdemeanor and a 19 crime involving moral turpitude which bears a substantial 20 relationship under Section 2910 of the Regulations to the 21 qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

23 The crimes for which Respondent was convicted as 24 described in Paragraphs IV through V, above, constitute cause 25 under Sections 490 and 10177(b) of the Code for suspension or revocation of all licenses and license rights of Respondent under 26 27 the Real Estate Law.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be
conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon
proof thereof, a Decision be rendered imposing disciplinary
action against all licenses and license rights of Respondent
under the Code, and for such other and further relief as may be
proper under provisions of law.
