On or about March 1, 2011, in the Superior Court of the State of California, County of Santa Clara, Case No. C1081183, Respondent was convicted of violating two (2) counts of section 6203 of the Government Code (knowingly making false statements in a certificate or writing), misdemeanors which bear a substantial relationship under section 2910, title 10, California Code of Regulations (herein "the Regulations") to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

4.

The facts alleged above in Paragraph 3 constitute grounds for the denial under section 2746, title 10, California Code of Regulations and section 10177(d) of the Business and Processions Code of Respondent's application to become the designated broker-officer of Back on Track, Inc.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that the above-entitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of a corporate real estate broker license to Respondent, and for such other and further relief as may be proper in the premises.
