2	to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee.

4	Respondent's conviction identified in paragraph 2, above, constitutes cause
5	under Sections 490 (conviction of crime) and 10177(b) (conviction of crime substantially
6	related to qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee) of the Code for the
7	suspension or revocation of all licenses and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate
8	Law.

11	Section 10106 of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in
12	resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the Bureau, the commissioner may request the
13	administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to
14	pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.
15	WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations
16	of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered revoking all licenses and
17	license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and
18	Professions Code), for the cost of investigation and enforcement as permitted by law, and for
19	such other and further relief as may be proper under other provisions of law.
