I further agree that upon acceptance by the Commissioner, as evidenced by an appropriate order, all affidavits and all relevant evidence obtained by the Bureau in this matter prior to the Commissioner's acceptance, and all allegations contained in the Accusation filed in the Bureau Case No. H-11859 SF may be considered by the Bureau to be true and correct for the purpose of deciding whether to grant re-licensure or reinstatement pursuant to Government Code section 11522.
- 4. I further understand and agree that upon acceptance by the Commissioner, as evidenced by an appropriate order, of my petition to voluntarily surrender all of my licenses and license rights under the Real Estate Law, the Bureau will take no further disciplinary action related to the Accusation filed in Bureau Case No. H-11859 SF, with the exception of the use of such affidavits, evidence, and allegations as outlined above in Paragraph 3.

I further understand and agree that prior to and as a condition of any petition for reinstatement made pursuant to Government Code section 11522 being granted, I agree to be jointly and severally responsible, along with my co-Respondent LILIANA RODRIGUEZ, for paying the Commissioner's reasonable cost of the investigation and enforcement which led to this disciplinary action in Bureau Case No. H-11859. The amount of said costs are \$3,851.20.
