| 23       | On June 3, 2024, Respondent petitioned for reinstatement of said real estate   |

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| 1  | I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence submitted in support                        |
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| 2  | thereof. Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent meets the requirements       |

| 4  | would not be against the public interest to issue said license to Respondent.                        |
