The facts alleged above, in Paragraph 2, constitute grounds under Sections 490 and 10177(b) of the Code for suspension or revocation of all licenses and license rights of Respondent under Part 1 of Division 4 of the Code.

A diligent search was made of the records of the Bureau, relating to Respondent's Real Estate License. As a result of said search, no written record was discovered of Respondent notifying the Bureau of any conviction.

5

The facts alleged above, in Paragraphs 2 through 4, constitute a violation of Section 10186.2 (failure to report in writing, conviction within 30 days) of the Code, and are grounds for the suspension or revocation of all licenses and license rights of Respondent under Section 10177(d) of the Code.

Section 10106 of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the department, the Commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.
