As Respondent was checking out prior to exiting the Exam Center, a proctor noticed Respondent had writing on her left hand, in violation of sections 123, 123.5, 496, 10153.01, and 10153.10 of the Business and Professions Code ("the Code"), and section 2763 of Chapter 6, Title 10, of the California Code of Regulations.
- 4. A Bar Order is in the public interest in that the Respondent has violated provisions of the Code, which said violations were known to Respondent, or should have been known to the Respondent.

Please take notice that the Commissioner seeks to bar and prohibit you for a period of thirty-six (36) months from the effective date of the Bar Order from engaging in any of the following activities in the State of California:

- A. From participating in an examination for licensure;
- B. Holding any position of employment, management, or control in a real estate business;
- C. Participating in any business activity of a real estate salesperson or a real estate broker;
- D. Engaging in any real estate related business activity on the premises where a real estate salesperson or real estate broker is conducting business; and
- E. Participating in any real estate related business activity of a finance lender, residential mortgage lender, bank credit union, escrow company, title company, or underwritten title company.

YOU ARE IMMEDIATELY PROHIBITED FROM ENGAGING IN ANY BUSINESS ACTIVITY INVOLVING REAL ESTATE THAT IS SUBJECT TO REGULATION UNDER THE REAL ESTATE LAW.

NOTICE OF RIGHT AND OPPORTUNITY FOR A HEARING

Pursuant to Section 10087 of the Code, Respondent has the right to request a hearing under the California Administrative Procedure Act (Chapter 4.5 – commencing with

Section 11400 of the Government Code). If Respondent desires a hearing, Respondent must submit a written request within fifteen (15) days after the mailing or service of this "Notice of Intention to Issue Bar Order and Preliminary Bar Order." The request may be in any form provided it is in writing, includes Respondent's current return address, indicates that Respondent wants a hearing, is signed by Respondent or on Respondent's behalf, and is mailed to the Bureau of Real Estate, P. O. Box 137007, Sacramento, California 95813-7007, Attention: Legal Section; or, delivered personally to the offices of the Bureau of Real Estate, 1651 Exposition Blvd., Sacramento, California.

If no hearing is requested within said fifteen (15) day time period, Respondent's failure to request a hearing shall constitute a waiver of the right to a hearing.
