duties of a real estate licensee pursuant to Section 2910, Title 10, of the California Code of Regulations ("the Regulations").

On or about February 22, 2013, in the Second Judicial District Court, County of Bernalillo, State of New Mexico, Case No. 2012-00898, Respondent was convicted of violating Section 30-31-23 of the New Mexico Statutes Annotated (possession of a controlled substance methamphetamines), a misdemeanor and crime that bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee pursuant to Section 2910 of the Regulations.

The facts identified in Paragraphs 2 and 3, above, constitute cause under Section 490 (conviction of a crime), Section 10177(b) (conviction of a crime substantially related to qualifications, functions or duties of real estate licensee), and Section 10177(j) (conduct that constitutes fraud or dishonest dealing) of the Business and Professions Code for the denial of all licenses and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that the above-entitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of a real estate salesperson license to Respondent, and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other provisions of law.
