ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

On September 1, 2017, in Case No. H-12101 SF, an Order was executed which accepted the petition for the voluntary surrender of the real estate salesperson license of Respondent. The Order became effective on September 17, 2017.

On April 1, 2021, Respondent petitioned for reinstatement of said real estate salesperson license, and the Attorney General of the State of California has been given notice of the filing of the petition.

I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence submitted in support thereof. Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent meets the requirements of law for the issuance to Respondent of an unrestricted real estate salesperson license and that it would not be against the public interest to issue said license to Respondent.

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1 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's petition for
2 reinstatement is granted and that a real estate salesperson license be issued to Respondent if
3 Respondent satisfies the following requirements:

4 1. Submits a completed application and pays the fee for a real estate
5 salesperson license within the 12 month period following the date of this Order; and

6 2. Submits proof that Respondent has completed the continuing education
7 requirements for renewal of the license sought. The continuing education courses must be
8 completed either (i) within the 12 month period preceding the filing of the completed
9 application, or (ii) within the 12 month period following the date of this Order.

10 This Order shall become effective immediately.
