| 24 | On or about June 6, 2011, in the United Stated District Court, Northern District |
| 25 | of California, Case No. CR-10-00692-001-CRB, Respondent was convicted of violating Title |
| 26 | 18, Section 1349, of the United States Code (conspiracy to commit mail and wire fraud), a |

felony which bears a substantial relationship under section 2910, title 10, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee. **BAR ORDER** Effective July 23, 2013, in Case No. H-11493 SF, the Real Estate Commissioner issued a Bar Order prohibiting Respondent, for a period of thirty-six (36) months from, among other things, participating in any business activity of a real estate salesperson or a real estate broker. **GROUNDS FOR DENIAL** Respondent's criminal conviction, as described above in Paragraph 2, constitutes grounds under sections 480(a) and 10177(b) of the Code for the denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license. WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that the above-entitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of a real estate salesperson license to Respondent, and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other provisions of law.
