15	The Complainant, STEPHANIE YEE, in her official capacity as a Supervising
16	Special Investigator of the Department of Real Estate (Department) of the State of California,
17	previously filed an Accusation against Respondent RANDELL DUARTE SILVA
18	("Respondent"), on or about February 27, 2024. Complainant, in her official capacity, and
19	pursuant to Government Code Section 11507, now files this Amended Accusation, and is
20	informed and alleges as follows:
21	1
22	Respondent is presently licensed and/or has license rights under the Real Estate
23	Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code) (Code) as a real
24	estate salesperson, License ID 02064884.
25	Respondent was licensed by the Department as a real estate salesperson on or
26	about August 27, 2018. Respondent submitted an application for renewal of his real estate
27	salesperson license on or about July 7, 2022, prior to the August 26, 2022, expiration date. The
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1	Department approved renewal of Respondent's real estate salesperson license on or about August
2	27, 2022, with a new expiration date of August 26, 2026.
3	CRIMINAL CONVICTION
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5	On or about August 22, 2022, in the Superior Court of the State of California,
6	County of Contra Costa, Case No. 01-197679-4, Respondent was convicted of violating Sections
7	23920 (possession of firearm with identification numbers removed) and 236-237 (false
8	imprisonment) of the California Penal Code, crimes which bear a substantial relationship under
9	Section 2910 of Title 6 of the California Code of Regulations ("Regulations") to the
10	qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.
11	FAILURE TO DISCLOSE FELONY COMPLAINT
12	3
13	On or about July 7, 2022, Respondent submitted through the Department's
14	eLicensing online system, a Salesperson Renewal Application (Form RE 209) to renew his Real
15	Estate Salesperson license, License ID No. 02064884.
16	Item 13 under the "Background Information" section of the Salesperson Renewal
17	Application asked the following: "Are there criminal charges pending against you at this time,
18	or are you currently awaiting judgment and sentencing following entry of a plea or jury verdict?
19	If yes, complete Item 18." Respondent responded to Item 13 by checking the box "No" and did
20	not complete Item 18 which asked for an explanation of Item 13.
21	On or about December 8, 2021, and in the Superior Court of California, County
22	of Contra Costa, a felony criminal complaint, DA No: 0131035252, was filed by the Contra
23	Costa District Attorney's Office against Respondent.
24	Respondent selected "No" as to Item 13 above in his Salesperson Renewal
25	Application, despite having a felony criminal complaint filed against him at that time.
26	Respondent's answer of "No" to Item 13 in his Salesperson Renewal Application, as described
27	under Paragraph 3 herein, constitutes the procuring, or attempting to procure, a real estate
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1	license renewal by fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit, or by making a material misstatement of
2	facts in an application for a real estate license renewal.
3	FAILURE TO NOTIFY DEPARTMENT
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5	At no time did Respondent provide notice within 30 days of the bringing of an
6	indictment, the charging of a felony, the conviction of Respondent of one or more misdemeanor
7	and/or felony convictions, and/or any disciplinary action taken by another licensing agency, as
8	required by Section 10186.2 of the Code.
9	GROUNDS FOR DISCIPLINE
10	5
11	The facts alleged in Paragraph 2 constitute grounds under Sections 490
12	and 10177(b) of the Code for suspension or revocation of all licenses and license rights of
13	Respondent under Part 1 of Division 4 of the Code.
14	The facts alleged in Paragraph 3 constitute cause under Section 10177(a) of the
15	Code for suspension or revocation of all licenses and license rights of Respondent under Part 1 of
16	Division 4 of the Code.
17	The facts alleged in Paragraph 4 constitute cause under Sections 10177(d) and
18	10186.2 of the Code for suspension or revocation of all licenses and license rights of Respondent
19	under Part 1 of Division 4 of the Code.
20	COST RECOVERY

22	Section 10106 of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in
23	resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the Department, the Commissioner may request
24	the Administrative Law Judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this
25	part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the
26	case.
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WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all licenses and license rights of Respondent under the Code, for the cost of investigation and enforcement as permitted by law, and for such other and further relief as may be proper under the provisions of law.
