ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

On May 20, 1991, a Decision was rendered herein revoking the real estate broker license of Respondent, SHERI DEANE DAHLER (hereinafter "Respondent"), effective June 18, 1991. In said Decision Respondent was given the right to apply for and receive a restricted real estate broker license which was issued to her on July 16, 1991.

On June 6, 1997, Respondent petitioned for reinstatement of said real estate broker license and the Attorney General of the State of California has been given notice of the filing of said petition.

I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence and arguments in support thereof. Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that grounds do not presently



exist to deny the issuance of an unrestricted real estate broker license to Respondent.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's petition for reinstatement is granted and that an unrestricted real estate broker license be issued to Respondent, SHERI DEANE DAHLER, after Respondent satisfies the following conditions within one (1) year from the date of this Order:

- 1. Submittal of a completed application and payment of the fee for a real estate broker license.
- 2. Submittal of evidence satisfactory to the Real Estate Commissioner that Respondent has, during the last four years, taken and successfully completed the continuing education requirements of Article 2.5 of Chapter 3 of the Real Estate Law for renewal of a real estate license including three hour courses in trust fund accounting and handling and fair housing.

This Order shall become effective immediately.
