COURT PAPER STATE OF CALIFORNIA STD. 113 (REV. 8-72) On or about October 14, 1988, in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, Respondent was convicted of the crime of violating Section 11351 of the Health and Safety Code (Possession for Sale of a Controlled Substance), a felony and a crime involving moral turpitude which bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, California Code of Regulations, to the qualifications, functions or duties of real estate licensee.
