STATEMENT OF ISSUES

The Complainant, Thomas McCrady, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, for Statement of Issues against EVA ANTONIA SANDOVAL ("Respondent"), alleges as follows:

Ι

The Complainant, Thomas McCrady, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, makes this Statement of Issues in his official capacity.

ΙI

On or about March 3, 1995, an examination for a real estate salesperson license (hereinafter "Examination") was completed before the Department of Real Estate of the State of California (hereinafter "Department"), allegedly by Respondent. It was represented to the Department that Respondent was taking the Examination.

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III

2 In truth and in fact, one David Edward Wick, 3 impersonating Respondent, took and passed the Examination on 4 Respondent's behalf.

IV

On or about November 21, 1995 and February 28, 1996, Respondent made application to the Department for a real estate salesperson license with the knowledge and understanding that any license issued as a result of said application would be subject to the conditions of Code Section 10153.4.

In truth and in fact, Respondent had not taken and passed the Examination as represented. David Edward Wick took and passed the Examination which Respondent was obliged to take and pass in order for a license to be issued to her.

VI

The conduct, acts and/or omissions of Respondent, as set forth herein above, are violation of Code Section 10153 and constitute cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate salesperson license pursuant to Code Sections 10177(a) and/or 10177(d).

These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the Government Code.

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WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that the above-entitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of a real estate salesperson license to Respondent, EVA ANTONIA SANDOVAL, and for such other and further relief as may be proper in the premises.
