14	ORDER GRANTING REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS ON LICENSE
15	On July 15, 1999, a Decision was rendered herein revoking Respondent's real
16	estate broker license, but granting Respondent the right to the issuance of a restricted real estate
17	broker license. A restricted real estate broker license was issued to Respondent on September 16,
18	1999, and Respondent has held a restricted license since that time.
19	On November 13, 2018, Respondent petitioned for the removal of restrictions
20	attaching to Respondent's real estate broker license.
21	I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence submitted in support
22	thereof. Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent meets the requirements
23	of law for the issuance to Respondent of an unrestricted real estate broker license and that it
24	would not be against the public interest to issue said license to Respondent.

1	NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's petition for the
2	removal of restrictions attaching to Respondent's real estate broker license is granted and that a
3	real estate broker license be issued to Respondent if Respondent satisfies the following
4	requirements:
5	1. Submits a completed application and pays the fee for a real estate broker
6	license within the 12 month period following the date of this Order; and
7	2. Submits proof that Respondent has completed the continuing education
8	requirements for renewal of the license sought. The continuing education courses must be
9	completed either (i) within the 12 month period preceding the filing of the completed
10	application, or (ii) within the 12 month period following the date of this Order.
11	This Order shall become effective immediately.
