

NO. H-29173 LA RODNEY MALONE ORDER TO DESIST AND REFRAIN (B & P Code § 10086)

The Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California (hereinafter "Commissioner") has determined from the findings set forth below that you have violated Section 10130 of the Business and Professions Code (hereinafter "Code") by engaging in the business of a real estate broker within the State of California without a real estate broker license.

At no time herein mentioned, have you been licensed by the Department of Real Estate of the State of California (hereinafter "Department") as a real estate broker, nor are you a real estate salesperson employed by a real estate broker.

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II

During a period of time from July 1998 through
February 2000, for or in expectation of compensation, you acted
on behalf of prospective buyers, Alicia Pendleton and Cynthia
Shaw (mother and daughter respectively). When you initially
spoke with Ms. Shaw you represented to her that you were a Real
Estate Broker. You collected the following fees from Ms. Shaw:
a \$500.00 application fee; a \$500.00 escrow fee; and \$50.00
credit report fee. You have not returned any of said fees to
Shaw and no escrow was opened on her behalf for the purchase of
real property.

III

During the same period, while representing that you were a real estate broker, you made an offer on Ms. Pendleton's behalf to purchase real property located at 1482 Clifford, Rialto, California and, on April 4, 1999, collected an advance fee (that you described as an "administration fee") in the form of a personal check of \$500.00 made payable to Robbie Browne.

Ms. Pendleton provided another check in the amount of \$500.00 for deposit into escrow. Escrow was opened on May 27, 1999 for said property and canceled on or about February 11, 2000. You did not return the advance fee that you collected from Ms. Pendleton.

IV

Your acts, as described in Paragraphs II and III, above, are acts requiring a real estate license under the

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provision of Code Section 10131(a).

V

You violated Code Section 10130 by engaging in the activities described in Paragraphs II and III, above, without first obtaining a real estate license from the Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, YOU ARE ORDERED TO DESIST AND REFRAIN from performing any and all acts requiring a real estate license in the State of California, until you obtain the required license from the Department.
