

STATEMENT OF ISSUES

The Complainant, Thomas McCrady, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, for Statement of Issues against MARIA LUZ MAYTORENA (hereinafter "Respondent") is informed and alleges in his official capacity as follows:

Respondent.

I

On or about April 10, 2001, Respondent applied to the Department of Real Estate of the State of California for a real estate salesperson license with the knowledge and understanding that any license issued as a result would be subject to the conditions of Section 10153.4 of the Business and Professions Code.

In response to Question 25 of said application, to wit: "HAVE YOU EVER BEEN CONVICTED OF ANY VIOLATION OF LAW? (You may omit convictions for drunk driving, reckless driving, and minor traffic citations which do not constitute a misdemeanor or felony offense), " Respondent answered "No" and failed to disclose the conviction set forth below in Paragraph III.

III

On or about November 14, 1985, in the Chino Municipal Court of the State of California, in case number MCH8077, Respondent, upon her plea guilty, was convicted of a violation of Penal Code Section 488 (petty theft), a misdemeanor crime which by its facts and circumstances involves moral turpitude and is substantially related under Section 2910, Title 10, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

IV

Respondent's failure to disclose the conviction set forth in Paragraph III, above, in said application, constitutes the procurement of a real estate license by misrepresentation, fraud or deceit or by making a material misstatement of fact in said application which is cause for denial of issuance of a license to an applicant under Sections 498 and 10177(a) of the California Business and Professions Code.

Further, the crime of which Respondent was convicted, as described above in Paragraph III, constitutes cause for denial of her application for a real estate license under Sections 480(a) and 10177(b) of the California Business and Professions Code.

The Statement of Issues is brought under the provisions of Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the Government Code.

WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that the aboveentitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the
charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to
authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of a real
estate license to Respondent, MARIA LUZ MAYTORENA, and for such
other and further relief as may be proper in the premises.
