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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, pursuant to the authority granted under Section 11520 of the Government Code of the State of California, that the application of ROBERT BENJAMIN KIRKLAND IV for a real estate salesperson license is hereby denied. In response to Question 25 of said license application, 5 to wit: "Have you ever been convicted of any violation of law? (You may omit convictions for drunk driving, reckless driving, and minor traffic citation which do not constitute a misdemeanor or felony offense)." Respondent checked the box denoting "No". Respondent failed to disclose the conviction set forth below.

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On March 4, 1999, in the Superior Court of California, Harbor 12 Judicial District, County of Orange, State of California, 13 respondent was convicted upon a guilty plea to one count of 14 15 violating California Penal Code Section 148.9(a) of (false 16 representing self to a peace officer), a misdemeanor crime, which 17 by its facts and circumstances involves moral turpitude and is 18 substantially related under Section 2910, Chapter 6, Title 10 of 19 the California Code of Regulations, to the qualifications, 20 functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

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23 application, constitutes an attempt to procure a real estate 24 license by fraud, misrepresentation or deceit or by making a 25 material misstatement of fact on his application, which is cause 26 for denial of respondent's application for a real estate 27

Respondent's failure to reveal the conviction in his

salesperson's license under Code Sections 475(a), 480(c) and 10177(a).

These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California and Sections 111500 through 11528 of the Government Code of the State of California.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that the above-entitled matter be set for hearing and, that upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a real estate salesperson license to Respondent ROBERT BENJAMIN KIRKLAND IV and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
