

BEFORE THE DEPARTMENT OF REAL ESTATE

STATE OF CALIFORNIA

The Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California (hereinafter "Commissioner") has determined from the findings set forth below that you have violated Section 10130 of the Business and Professions Code (hereinafter "Code") by engaging in the business of a real estate broker within the State of California without a real estate broker license.

I

At no time herein mentioned, have you been licensed by the Department of Real Estate of the State of California (hereinafter "Department") as a real estate broker, nor are you a real estate salesperson employed by a real estate broker.

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On or about April 27, 2000, you submitted Form RE 204 (Broker Change Application) to the Department's Licensing and Examinations Department located in Sacramento, adding the dbas Empire Worldwide Funding and Empire Funding to the broker license of Evelyn Ann Pierre. You did so without the knowledge or consent of Ms. Pierre.

II

III

During a period of time from December 2000 through July 24, 2001, for or in expectation of compensation, you acted on behalf of a Matthew Obar, representing him in the refinance of his home loan on real property located at 5459 Valley Ridge Avenue, Los Angeles, California.

IV

During the same period and regarding the same property, you represented yourself to Matthew Obar and American Major Funding as a licensed real estate salesperson employed by licensed real estate broker, Evelyn Ann Pierre, dba Empire Worldwide Funding and Empire Funding.

V

On or about July 24, 2001, regarding the same transaction described above at Paragraph III, for or in expectation of compensation, you received two checks from American Major Escrow, one in the amount of \$3,451.50 and the other in the amount of \$2,500.00. Said checks represented commission money you requested by written instruction submitted to American Major Escrow from the proceeds of Mr. Obar's

refinance.

VI

Your acts as described in Paragraphs III, IV and V above, are acts requiring a real estate license under the provision of Code Section 10131(d).

IIV

You violated Code Section 10130 by engaging in the activities described in Paragraphs III, IV and V above, without first obtaining a real estate license from the Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, YOU ARE ORDERED TO DESIST AND REFRAIN from performing any and all acts requiring a real estate license in the State of California, until you obtain the required license from the Department.
