STATEMENT OF ISSUES

ROBERT MEYER WENNING, Respondent.

In the Matter of the Application of )

The Complainant, Maria Suarez, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, for Statement of Issues against ROBERT MEYER WENNING (hereinafter "Respondent") is informed and alleges in her official capacity as follows:

On or about February 21, 2002, Respondent applied to the Department of Real Estate of the State of California for a real estate salesperson license with the knowledge and understanding that any license issued as a result would be subject to the conditions of Sections 10153.4 of the Business and Professions Code (hereinafter "Code").

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ΙI

In response to Question 25 of said application, to wit:
"HAVE YOU EVER BEEN CONVICTED OF ANY VIOLATION OF LAW?

Convictions expunged under Penal Code Section 1203.4 must be disclosed. However, you may omit minor traffic citations which do not constitute a misdemeanor or felony offense." Respondent answered "Yes" and indicated that he had one felony conviction that occurred in 1998. In fact, Respondent has another conviction that occurred in 1999 that he failed to reveal on said application.

III

On or about August 31, 1998, in the Municipal Court of South Bay Judicial District, County of Los Angeles, State of California, in case number YA037544, Respondent, upon his plea of nolo contendere, was convicted of a violating Section 11359 of the Health and Safety Code (Possess Marijuana/Hashish for Sale) a felony crime that is substantially related under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

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On or about August 13, 1999, in the Municipal Court of South Bay Judicial District, County of Los Angeles, State of California, in case number 9SB01413, Respondent, upon his plea of nolo contendere, was convicted on violating Section 23103(a) of the Vehicle Code (Reckless Driving). Respondent did not reveal

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this conviction in his application for a real estate salesperson license.

V

Respondent's failure to disclose the conviction, as set forth in Paragraph IV above, constitutes the procurement of a real estate license by misrepresentation, fraud or deceit or by making a material misstatement of fact in said application which is cause for denial of issuance of a license to an applicant under Sections 475(a)(1), 480(c) and 10177(a) of the Code.

VI

Further, the crime for which Respondent was convicted, as described above in Paragraph III, constitutes cause for denial of his application for a real estate license under Sections 475(a)(2), 480(a)(1) and 10177(b) of the Code. The crime for which Respondent was convicted, as described above in Paragraph IV, constitutes cause for denial of his application for a real estate license under Sections 475(a)(2) and 480(a)(1) of the Code.

The Statement of Issues is brought under the provisions of Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the Government Code.

WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that the aboveentitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to

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authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of a real estate license to Respondent, ROBERT MEYER WENNING, and for such other and further relief as may be proper in the premises.
