ORDER TO DESIST AND REFRAIN

(B&P Section 10086)

The Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California has caused an investigation to be conducted and is of the opinion that you have violated Section 10130 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California in that you engaged in property management activities which require a real estate license without first obtaining a real estate broker This opinion is based on the findings set forth below.

Beginning on or before February 1, 2002, and at various times thereafter in Los Angeles County, California, for compensation or in expectation of compensation, you solicited

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prospective tenants for, negotiated rental agreements for and collected rents from real properties owned by another or others. Included in the rental properties owned by another or others for which you performed property management activities were the following:

a) 45505 10th St West Lancaster, California 91321

Collected rents and managed rental property located at this address on behalf of Joseph Shaber between February 1, 2002 and August 28, 2002 and received compensation for these services.

b) 38437 10th Place East, #2 Palmdale, California 93550

On or about March 27, 2002, CELIA GALLARDO in person and in writing solicited a resident of rental property located at 38437 10th Place East, #2, in Palmdale, California 93550 to negotiate a one year lease on behalf of the owners of the property, Kevin and Rebecca Carasco. On or about April 6, 2002, Gallardo Property Management sent a letter to a resident of rental property notifying her that the rent would be increased.

c) As of September 11, 2002, GALLARDO PROPERTY MANAGEMENT, INC. managed approximately 100 properties, of which 23 are owned by CELIA GALLARDO.

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By the commission of the acts alleged above, you, CELIA GALLARDO, and you, GALLARDO PROPERTY MANAGEMENT, INC., individually, as a corporation, and doing business as Gallardo Property Management, engaged in the business and acted in the capacity of a real estate broker within the State of California as defined by Section 10131(b) of the Business and Professions Code.

 Prior to engaging in the business and acting in the capacity of a real estate broker within the State of California, you failed to obtain a real estate broker license from the Department of Real Estate in violation of Section 10130 of the Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, YOU ARE ORDERED TO DESIST AND REFRAIN from performing any and all acts within the State of California for which a real estate broker license is required, individually, as a corporation and under any fictitious business name, unless and until you obtain a real estate broker license from the Department of Real Estate.
