
failed to file a Notice of Defense, request a hearing or otherwise establish that he is entitled to the license sought.

Respondent.

The Complainant, Janice Waddell, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, for Statement of Issues against SOHEL KHAN (respondent) is informed and alleges in her official capacity as follows:

1.

Respondent made application to the Department of Real Estate of the State of California for a real estate salesperson license on or about June 30 2003, with the knowledge and understanding that any license issued as a result of said applicaitn would be suject to Section 10153.4 under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Califrona Busienss and Professions Code) (Code).

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2.

On June 5, 2002, in the Municipal Court of California, County of Los Angeles, respondent was convicted upon a guilty plea to one count of California Vehicle Code Section 23152(a) (DUI), a misdemeanor.

3.

On May 19, 1999, in the Superior Court of Southeast - South Gate Judicial District, County of Los Angeles, respondent was convicted upon a plea of nolo contendere to one count of California Vehicle Code Section 23152(b) (DUI - .08 weight of alcohol), a misdemeanor.

4.

The crimes set forth in Paragraphs 2 and 3, by their facts and circumstances, are substantially related under Section 2910(a)(11), Chapter 6, Title 10 of the California Code of Regulations, to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

5.

These crimes constitute cause for denial of respondent's application for a real estate license under Code Section 480(a).

6.

IN AGGRAVATION

Respondent's multiple driving-related alcohol offenses demonstrate a lack of respect for the legal system and constitute

a continuing threat of future harm by means of the potentially dangerous physical consequences to both respondent and third parties while drinking and driving.

These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Section 10100, Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code and Sections 11500 through 11529 of the California Government Code.

WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that above-entitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a real estate salesperson license to respondent SOHEL KHAN, and for such other and further relief as may be proper in the premises.
