## ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

On May 5, 2005, a Decision was rendered herein revoking the real estate salesperson license of Respondent, but granting the right to apply for and be issued a restricted real estate salesperson license. Respondent failed to apply for a restricted license.

On February 28, 2008, Respondent petitioned for reinstatement of Respondent's salesperson license. On December 29, 2008, an Order Denying Reinstatement of License and Granting Right to a Restricted License was rendered. Respondent was given the right to apply for and be issued a restricted real estate salesperson license. On June 11, 2009, a restricted real estate salesperson license was issued to Respondent.

On or about January 18, 2011, Respondent petitioned for reinstatement of said real estate salesperson license. The Attorney General of the State of California has been given notice of the filing of Respondent's petition.

I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence and arguments submitted in support thereof. Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent meets the requirements of law for the issuance to Respondent of an unrestricted real estate salesperson license and that it would not be against the public interest to issue said license to Respondent.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's petition for reinstatement is granted and that a real estate salesperson license be issued to Respondent, if Respondent satisfies the following requirements:

- 1. Submits a completed application and pays the fee for a real estate salesperson license within the 12 month period following the date of this Order; and
- 2. Submits proof that Respondent has completed the continuing education requirements for renewal of the license sought. The continuing education courses must be completed either (i) within the 12 month period preceding the filing of the completed application, or (ii) within the 12 month period following the date of this Order.

This Order shall be effective immediately.
