DECISION

This Decision is being issued in accordance with the provisions of Section 11520 of the Government Code, on evidence of compliance with Section 11505 of the Government Code and pursuant to the Order of Default filed on January 6, 2005, and the findings of fact set forth herein are based on one or more of the following: (1) Respondent's express admissions; (2) affidavits; and (3) other evidence.

This Decision suspends or revokes one or more real estate licenses on grounds of the conviction of a crime.

The right to reinstatement of a revoked license is controlled by Section 11522 of the Government Code. A copy of the Commissioner's <u>Criteria of Rehabilitation</u> is attached hereto for the information of the Respondent.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Ι

On August 26, 2004, Maria Suarez made the Accusation in her official capacity as a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California. The Accusation, Statement to Respondent, and Notice of Defense were mailed, by certified mail, to Respondent's last known mailing address on file with the Department on September 1, 2004, and, by regular mail, on October 4, 2004.

On January 6, 2005, no Notice of Defense having been filed herein within the time prescribed by Section 11506 of the Government Code, Respondent's default was entered herein.

II

Respondent is presently licensed and/or has license rights under the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code (hereinafter "Code") as a real estate broker.

III

On or about May 19, 2003, in the Superior Court of California, County of San Bernardino, Respondent was convicted of violating California Vehicle Code Section 23152(b) (Driving with Blood Alcohol 0.08% or More).

IV

On or about April 24, 2000, in the Superior Court of California, County of Riverside, Respondent was convicted of violating California Vehicle Code Section 23152(b) (Driving with Blood Alcohol 0.08% or More).

V

The evidence established that the crimes of which Respondent was convicted involve moral turpitude and are substantially related to the qualifications, functions and duties of a real estate licensee.

DETERMINATION OF ISSUES

Cause for disciplinary action against Respondent exists pursuant to Business and Professions Code Sections $\underline{490}$ and $\underline{10177}\,(b)$.

The standard of proof applied was clear and convincing proof to a reasonable certainty.

The licenses and license rights of Respondent GARY LEROY BAUMAN under the provisions of Part I of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code, are revoked.
