ORDER SUSPENDING RESTRICTED REAL ESTATE LICENSE

On July 21, 2005, the Real Estate Commissioner approved the Stipulation and Agreement as his Decision in Department Case No. H-31828 LA. The Decision granted a restricted real estate salesperson license subject to terms, conditions, and restrictions, including but not limited to the following:

6. During the term of any restricted license, Respondent shall submit to the Department of Real Estate as of the last day of each March, June, September and December, proof satisfactory to the Real Estate Commissioner of Respondent's ongoing participation in a recognized alcohol diversion program. Said proof shall be submitted to the

Manager of the Crisis Response Team at the Los Angeles Office of the Department of Real Estate and shall be verified as true and accurate by Respondent under penalty of perjury.

The Commissioner may suspend the restricted license issued to Respondent pending a hearing held in accordance with Section 11500 et seq., of the Government Code, if such proof is not timely submitted as provided for herein, or as provided for in a subsequent agreement between the Respondent and the Commissioner. The suspension shall remain in effect until such proof is submitted or until Respondent enters into an agreement satisfactory to the Commissioner to provide such proof, or until a decision providing otherwise is adopted following a hearing held pursuant to this condition.

Respondent was issued a restricted real estate salesperson license on August 22, 2005, but failed to provide a report of participation in a recognized alcohol diversion program for the quarters ending September and December 2009; March, June, September, and December 2010; and March and June 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED under authority of California Business and Professions Code Section 10156.7 that Respondent's restricted real estate salesperson license and the exercise of any privileges thereunder are hereby suspended until Respondent enters into an agreement satisfactory to the Commissioner to provide such proof or a decision providing otherwise is adopted following a hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all license certificates and identification cards issued by the Department of Real Estate which are in the possession of Respondent be immediately surrendered by personal delivery or by mailing in the enclosed self-addressed envelope to:

HEARING RIGHTS: You have the right to a hearing to contest the Commissioner's determination that you are in violation of the Order issued in this matter. If you desire a hearing, you must submit a written request. The request may be in any form, as long as it is in writing and indicates that you want a hearing. Unless a written request for a hearing, signed by or on behalf of you, is delivered or mailed to the Department of Real Estate at 320 West 4th Street, Suite 350, Los Angeles, CA 90013-1105, within 20 days after the date that this Order was mailed to or served on you, the Department of Real Estate will not be obligated or required to provide you with a hearing.
