

ORDER ACCEPTING VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF REAL ESTATE LICENSE

On May 25, 2005, an Accusation was filed in this matter against Respondent JUST SECONDS, INC.

On June 6, 2005, Respondent petitioned the Commissioner to voluntarily surrender its real estate broker license pursuant to Section 10100.2 of the Business and Professions Code.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent JUST SECONDS's petition for voluntary surrender of its real estate broker license is accepted as of the effective date of this Order as set forth below, based upon the understanding and agreement expressed in Respondent's Declaration dated June 6, 2005 (attached as

DECLARATION

My name is Jayne Rincon Seppinni and that I am currently an officer of JUST SECONDS, INC., which is licensed as a real estate broker and/or has license rights with respect to said license. I am authorized and empowered to sign this declaration on behalf of JUST SECONDS, INC. I am acting on behalf of JUST SECONDS, INC. in this matter.

In lieu of proceeding in this matter in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (Sections 11400 et seq., of the Business and Professions Code) JUST SECONDS, INC. wishes to voluntarily surrender its real estate 1

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license issued by the Department of Real Estate ("Department"), pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 10100.2.

I understand that JUST SECONDS, INC., by so voluntarily surrendering its license, can only have it reinstated in accordance with the provisions of Section 11522 of the Government Code. I also understand that by so voluntarily surrendering its license, JUST SECONDS, INC. agrees to the following:

The filing of this Declaration shall be deemed as its petition for voluntary surrender. It shall also be deemed to be an understanding and agreement by JUST SECONDS, INC. that, it waives all rights it has to require the Commissioner to prove the allegations contained in the Accusation filed in this matter at a hearing held in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (Government Code Sections 11400 et seq.), and that it also waives other rights afforded to it in connection with the hearing such as the right to discovery, the right to present evidence in defense of the allegations in the Accusation and the right to cross-examine witnesses. agree on behalf of JUST SECONDS, INC. that upon acceptance by the Commissioner, as ovidenced by an appropriate order, all affidavits and all relevant evidence obtained by the Department in this matter prior to the Commissioner's acceptance, and all allegations contained in the Accusation filed in the Department Case No. H-31953 LA, may be considered by the Department to be true and correct for the purpose of deciding whether or not to grant reinstatement of JUST SECONDS, INC.'s license pursuant to Government Code Section 11522.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the above is true and correct and that I am acting freely and voluntarily on behalf of JUST SECONDS, INC. to surrender its license and all license rights attached thereto.

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JUST SECONDS, INC. (hereinafter referred to as "Respondent") is presently licensed and/or has license rights under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code, hereinafter "Code").

III

At all times herein mentioned, respondent JUST SECONDS, INC. was licensed by the Department of Real Estate of the State of California as a corporate real estate broker.

IV

On November 1, 2004, pursuant to the provisions of the California Bank and Corporation Tax Law, more particularly Section 23302 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, the Franchise Tax Board transmitted a list to the Office of the Secretary of State containing the names of domestic corporations, the exercise of whose powers, rights and privileges in this State had been suspended under that law, which included the above-named corporation.

V

On or about May 11, 2004, in Docket No. 0410, the South Carolina Department of Consumer Affairs, State of South Carolina, revoked the mortgage loan license of Respondent Just Seconds, Inc. for failure to renew, replace, and maintain a bond or other evidence of financial responsibility, and the failure to obtain a signed mortgage loan broker contract or other evidence of compliance with S.C. Code Ann. 40-58-75 in violation of the

Mortgage Loan Broker Act, S.C. Code Ann. 40-58-40, 55, 65 and 75 without limitation. VI The conduct, acts and omissions of respondent JUST SECONDS, INC., as alleged in Paragraph IV above, was in violation of Section 2742, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations. The conduct, acts and omissions of respondent subjects its real estate license and license rights to suspension or revocation pursuant to Sections 10177(d) and 10177(f) of the Code. WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all licenses and license rights of respondent JUST SECONDS, INC., under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code) and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
