15	It is hereby stipulated by and between EMILIO MONTELONGO JACINTO (hereinafter		
16	"Respondent") and Respondent's attorney, Joel R. Strote, and the Complainant, acting by and through Elliott Mac Lennan, Counsel for the Department of Real Estate, as follows for the purpose of settling and		
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18	disposing of the Statement of Issues filed on July 6, 2006 in this matter:	· .	
19	Respondent acknowledges that Respondent has received and read	the Statement of Issues and the	
20	Statement to Respondent filed by the Department of Real Estate in conn	ection with Respondent's	
21	application for a real estate salesperson license. Respondent understand	s that the Real Estate Commissioner	
22	may hold a hearing on this Statement of Issues for the purpose of requir	ing further proof of Respondent's	
23	honesty and truthfulness and to prove other allegations therein, or that h	e may in his discretion waive the	
. 24	hearing and grant Respondent a restricted real estate salesperson license	based upon this Stipulation and	
25	Waiver. Respondent also understands that by filing the Statement of Issues in this matter the Real Estate		
26	Commissioner is shifting the burden to Respondent to make a satisfactory showing that Respondent meets		
27	all the requirements for issuance of a real estate salesperson license. Respondent further understands that by		
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entering into this stipulation and waiver Respondent will be stipulating that the Real Estate Commissioner has found that Respondent has failed to make such a showing, thereby justifying the denial of the issuance to Respondent of an unrestricted real estate salesperson license.

Respondent hereby admits that the allegations of the Statement of Issues filed against Respondent are true and correct and requests that the Real Estate Commissioner in his discretion issue a restricted real estate salesperson license to Respondent under the authority of Section 10156.5 of the Business and Professions Code. Respondent understands that any such restricted license will be issued subject to and be limited by Section 10153.4 of the Business and Professions Code.

Respondent is aware that by signing this Stipulation and Waiver, Respondent is waiving Respondent's
right to a hearing and the opportunity to present evidence at the hearing to establish Respondent's
rehabilitation in order to obtain an unrestricted real estate salesperson license if this Stipulation and Waiver
is accepted by the Real Estate Commissioner. However, Respondent is not waiving Respondent's right to a
hearing and to further proceedings to obtain a restricted or unrestricted license if this Stipulation and
Waiver is not accepted by the Commissioner.

Respondent further understands that the following conditions, limitations, and restrictions will attach to a restricted license issued by the Department of Real Estate pursuant hereto:

- 1. The license shall not confer any property right in the privileges to be exercised including the right of renewal, and the Real Estate Commissioner may by appropriate order suspend the right to exercise any privileges granted under this restricted license in the event of:
 - a. The conviction of Respondent (including a plea of nolo contendere) to a crime which bears a substantial relationship to Respondent's fitness or capacity as a real estate licensee; or
 - b. The receipt of evidence that Respondent has violated provisions of the California Real Estate Law, the Subdivided Lands Law, Regulations of the Real Estate Commissioner, or conditions attaching to this restricted license.
 - 2. Respondent shall not be eligible to apply for the issuance of an unrestricted real estate license nor the removal of any of the conditions, limitations or restrictions attaching to the restricted

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license until two years have elapsed from the date of issuance of the restricted license to Respondent.

- 3. With the application for license, or with the application for transfer to a new employing broker, Respondent shall submit a statement signed by the prospective employing broker on a form approved by the Department of Real Estate wherein the employing broker shall certify as follows:
 - a. That broker has read the Statement of Issues which is the basis for the issuance of the restricted license; and

b. That broker will carefully review all transaction documents prepared by the restricted licensee and otherwise exercise close supervision over the licensee's performance of acts for which a license is required.

- 4. Respondent's restricted real estate salesperson license is issued subject to the requirements of Section 10153.4 of the Business and Professions Code, to wit: Respondent is required, within eighteen (18) months of the issuance of the restricted license, to submit evidence satisfactory to Commissioner of successful completion, the accredited institution, at an of a course in real estate practices and one of the courses listed in Section 10153.2, other than real estate principles, advanced legal aspects of real estate, advanced real estate finance, or advanced real estate appraisal. If Respondent fails to timely present to the Department satisfactory evidence of successful completion of the two required courses, the restricted license shall be automatically suspended effective eighteen (18) months after the date of its issuance. Said suspension shall not be lifted unless, prior to the expiration of the restricted license, Respondent has submitted the required evidence of course completion and the Commissioner has given written notice to Respondent of the lifting of the suspension.
 - 5. Pursuant to Section 10154, if Respondent has not satisfied the requirements for an unqualified license under Section 10153.4, Respondent shall not be entitled to renew the restricted license; and shall not be entitled to the issuance of another license which is subject to Section 10153.4 until four years after the date of the issuance of the preceding restricted license.

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1 In response to Question 25 of said license application, 2 to wit: "Have you ever been convicted of any violation of law? 3 Convictions expunged under Penal Code Section 1203.4 must be Δ disclosed. However, you may omit minor traffic citations which 5 do not constitute a misdemeanor or felony offense." Respondent 6 checked the box denoting "Yes". Respondent failed to disclose 7 8 the convictions set forth below. 9 3. 10 On May 29, 2003, in the Superior Court of California, 11 County of Ventura, bearing Case Number 2003010341, respondent was 12 convicted upon a guilty plea of Vehicle Code Section 12500(a) 13 (unlicensed driver), a misdemeanor. 14 4. 15 On July 10, 2002, in the Superior Court of California, 16 County of Ventura, bearing Case Number 2002019504, respondent was 17 convicted upon a guilty plea of Vehicle Code Section 12500(a) 18 (unlicensed driver), a misdemeanor. 19 5. 20 On April 27, 2001, in the Superior Court of California, 21 County of Ventura, bearing Case Number 2001010009, respondent was 22 23 convicted upon a guilty plea of Penal Code Section 12020(a) 24 (possess deadly weapon), a misdemeanor. 25 111 26 111 27

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These crimes by their facts and circumstances are 2 substantially related under Section 2910(a)(7), (a)(8) and 3 (a)(10), Chapter 6, Title 10 of the California Code of Λ Regulations, to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real 5 estate licensee and are cause to deny respondent's application б for a real estate license pursuant to Code Sections 480(a) and/or 7 8 10177(b).

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10 Respondent's failure to reveal the convictions above, 11 constitutes an attempt to procure a real estate license by fraud, 12 misrepresentation or deceit or by knowingly making a false 13 statement of fact on his application required to be revealed in 14 the application for such license, which is cause for denial of 15 respondent's application for a real estate salesperson's license 16 under Business and Professions Code Sections 475(a), 480(c) 17 and/or 10177(a). 18

These proceedings are brought under the provisions of 19 Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code of 20 the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the 21 Government Code of the State of California. 22
