These crimes involves moral turpitude, which bears a 10 substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 11 12 6, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee. 13 14 4. 15 (SPECIAL SENTENCING CONDITION) 16 Respondent's sentence for the crime of which 17 Respondent was convicted, as described in Paragraph 3 above, includes the condition that Respondent not be employed in any 18 19 position that requires licensing and/or certification by any local, state of federal agency without prior approval of the 20 Probation Officer.
