

DECLARATION

My name is Hakimullah Sarpas and I am currently licensed as a real estate salesperson and/or have license rights with respect to said license.

In lieu of proceeding in this matter in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (Sections 11400 et seq., of the Business and Professions Code) HAKIMULLAH SARPAS wishes to voluntarily surrender his real estate license issued by the Department of Real Estate ("Department") pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 10100.2.

I understand that by so voluntarily surrendering the license, HAKIMULLAH SARPAS can only have it reinstated in

accordance with the provisions of Section 11522 of the Government Code. I also understand that by so voluntarily surrendering the license, HAKIMULLAH SARPAS agrees to the following:

- (1) The filing of this Declaration shall be deemed as his petition for voluntary surrender.
- agreement by HAKIMULLAH SARPAS that he waives all rights he has to require the Commissioner to prove the allegations contained in the Accusation filed in this matter at a hearing held in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (Government Code Sections 11400 et seq.), and that he also waives other rights afforded to him in connection with the hearing such as the right to discovery, the right to present evidence in defense of the allegations in the Accusation and the right to cross-examine witnesses.
- (3) I further agree that upon acceptance by the Commissioner, as evidenced by an appropriate order, all affidavits and all relevant evidence obtained by the Department in this matter prior to the Commissioner's acceptance, and all allegations contained in the Accusation filed in the Department Case No. H-35854 LA may be considered by the Department to be true and correct for the purpose of deciding whether to grant relicensure of HAKIMULLAH SARPAS's license pursuant to Government Code Section 11522.
- (4) HAKIMULLAH SARPAS freely and voluntarily surrenders all of his licenses and license rights under the Real Estate Law.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the above is true and correct and that I am acting freely and voluntarily to surrender my license and all license rights attached thereto.

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

The Complainant, Robin L. Trujillo, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, for cause of Accusation against HAKIMULLAH SARPAS, alleges as follows:

Ι

The Complainant, Robin L. Trujillo, acting in her official capacity as a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, makes this Accusation against HAKIMULLAH SARPAS.

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ΙI

HAKIMULLAH SARPAS (hereinafter referred to as

"Respondent") is presently licensed and/or has license rights

under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business

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Respondent's activities are acts requiring a real estate broker license under the provisions of Code Section 10131(d) and (e).

III

At all times herein mentioned, Respondent was licensed by the Department of Real Estate of the State of California as a real estate salesperson dba Statewide Financial Group, Inc. and US Homeowners Assistance. From May 12, 2008 through August 14, 2008 Respondent was employed by real estate broker Frank Joseph Morris.

IV

During 2008, for or in expectation of compensation,
Respondent solicited and negotiated re-finance loans on real
property for borrowers Sherry Cole, Patricia Onnela, and Valerie
Walden.

V

Respondent violated Code Section 10145(c) by collecting advance fees from the borrowers and failing to turn the funds over to his employing broker. Respondent misappropriated the advance fees collected from the borrowers without the knowledge or permission of the borrowers.

The conduct of Respondent, as alleged above, subjects his real estate license and license rights to suspension or revocation pursuant to Sections 10177(f) and 10177(j) of the Code, and Section 10177(d) for violation of Code Sections 10130 and 10145(c).

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all licenses and license rights of Respondent HAKIMULLAH SARPAS under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code) and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
