ORDER TO DESIST AND REFRAIN

(B&P Code Section 10086)

The Commissioner ("Commissioner") of the California Department of Real Estate ("Department") caused an investigation to be made of the activities of RICHARD PETER MOHR ("MOHR"), individually, and doing business as RPM Real Estate Services, and has determined that MOHR has engaged in or is engaging in acts or practices constituting violations of the California Business and Professions Code ("Code") and/or Title 10, California Code of Regulations ("Regulations") including employing and/or compensating individuals who were not licensed by the Department to perform activities requiring a real estate license and failing to notify the Department of the employment of a real estate salesperson within five days of such employment. Based on the

findings of that investigation, as set forth below, the

Commissioner hereby issues the following Findings of Fact,

Conclusions of Law and Desist and Refrain Order pursuant to

Section 10086 of the Code.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. MOHR is presently licensed and/or has license

rights under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the

Code) as a real estate broker.

2. On or about March 12, 2009, MOHR engaged in the

business of negotiating, or offering to negotiate, loan

modifications in connection with loans secured directly or

collaterally by liens on real property for compensation or in

expectation of compensation.

- 3. MOHR employed and/or compensated Impresa

  Development Corporation doing business as Loan Fixers and Paul

  Chiavatta, neither of whom were licensed as a real estate

  salesperson or as a real estate broker, to perform some or all

  of the services alleged in Paragraph 2, above.
- 4. MOHR employed Andrew Lugo, an individual licensed by the Department as a real estate salesperson, to perform some or all of the services alleged in Paragraph 2, above, without notifying the Department of the employment within five days of its commencement.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. The activities described in Paragraph 2, above, require a real estate license under Sections 10131(d) of the Code.

Based on the information contained in Paragraphs 2 and 3, above, MOHR violated Section 10137 of the Code by employing and/or compensating individuals who were not licensed as a real estate salesperson or as a broker to perform activities requiring a real estate license. Based on the information contained in Paragraphs 2 and 4, above, MOHR violated Code Section 10161.8(a) and Section 2752 of the Regulations by employing a licensed 8 salesperson without notifying the Department within five days of such employment. 10 DESIST AND REFRAIN ORDER Based upon the FINDINGS OF FACT and CONCLUSIONS OF LAW stated herein, it is hereby ordered that RICHARD PETER MOHR 13 immediately desist and refrain from performing any acts within 14 the State of California for which a real estate broker license is 15 required until you comply with all provisions of the Real Estate 17 Law as discussed in this Order. 19 DATED:
