17	On August 23, 2010, a Decision was rendered revoking Respondent's real estate

21	On January 2, 2014, an Order Denying Reinstatement of License and Granting
22	Right to a Restricted License was signed by the Real Estate Commissioner.
23	On January 17, 2014, Respondent petitioned for reconsideration of said Decision.
24	I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence and arguments in support thereof.
25	Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent meets the requirements of law
26	for the issuance to Respondent of a real estate salesperson license and that it would not be against
27	the public interest to issue said license to Respondent.

1	NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's petition for
2	reconsideration is granted and that a real estate salesperson license be issued to Respondent if
3	Respondent satisfies the following requirements within the 12 month period following the date of
4	this Order:
5	1. Respondent shall qualify for, take and pass the real estate salespserson
6	license examination.
7	2. Submittal of a completed application and payment of the fee for a real
8	estate salesperson license.
9	This Order shall become effective immediately.
