DECISION AFTER RECONSIDERATION OF
ORDER DENYING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE AND
GRANTING RIGHT TO A RESTRICTED LICENSE

On August 23, 2010, a Decision was rendered revoking Respondent's real estate salesperson license. In 2009 Respondent was convicted of a misdemeanor assault PC245(a).

On December 05, 2012, Respondent petitioned for reinstatement of said real estate salesperson license.

On January 2, 2014, an Order Denying Reinstatement of License and Granting Right to a Restricted License was signed by the Real Estate Commissioner.

On January 17, 2014, Respondent petitioned for reconsideration of said Decision. I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence and arguments in support thereof. Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent meets the requirements of law for the issuance to Respondent of a real estate salesperson license and that it would not be against the public interest to issue said license to Respondent.

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NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's petition for
reconsideration is granted and that a real estate salesperson license be issued to Respondent if
Respondent satisfies the following requirements within the 12 month period following the date of
this Order:

1. Respondent shall qualify for, take and pass the real estate salesperson
license examination.

2. Submittal of a completed application and payment of the fee for a real
estate salesperson license.

This Order shall become effective immediately.
