DECISION

This Decision is being issued in accordance with the provisions of Section 11520 of the Government Code, on evidence of compliance with Section 11505 of the Government Code and pursuant to the Order of Default filed on July 19, 2010 and the findings of fact set forth herein are based on one or more of the following: (1) Respondents THE STANDARD GROUP INC.'s ("Respondent STANDARD") and WILLIAM SEHYOK OH's ("Respondent OH") express admissions; (2) affidavits; and (3) other evidence.

This Decision suspends of revokes one or more real estate—licenses—on—the—ground—of—violation—of—the—Real—Estate—Law (commencing with section 10000 of the Business and Professions Code (Code)) Chapter 1 (commencing with Section 11000 of the Code) of Part 2 or the rules and regulations of the commissioner for the administration and enforcement of the Real Estate Law and Chapter 1 (commencing with section 11000 of the Code) of Part 2.

The right to reinstatement of a revoked real estate license or to the reduction of a suspension is controlled by Section 11522 of the Government Code. A copy of Section 11522 and a copy of the Commissioner's Criteria of Rehabilitation are attached hereto for the information of the Respondent.

FINDINGS OF FACT

I

On November 5, 2009, Robin Trujillo made the Accusation in her official capacity as a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California. The Accusation, Statement to Respondent, and Notice of Defense were mailed by certified mail to Respondents last known mailing address on file with the Department on November 17, 2009, and December 15, 2009.

Respondents failed to file a Notice of Defense within the time required by Section 11506 of the Government Code. Respondent's default was entered herein.

II

Respondent STANDARD is presently licensed and/or has license rights under the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code (hereinafter "Code") as a real estate corporation acting by and through Respondent OH as its designated broker-officer.

III

Respondent OH is presently licensed and/or has license rights under the Real Estate Law as a real estate broker. On or about August 13, 2008, the license of Respondent OH expired.

IV ·

On or about April 27, 2009, the final judgment of the Superior Court of the State of California, County of Los Angeles, Case No. BC401612, was entered against Respondent STANDARD and Respondent OH based on the ground of fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit with reference to a transaction for which a real estate license is required.

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DETERMINATION OF ISSUES

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Cause for disciplinary action against Respondents THE STANDARD GROUP INC. and WILLIAM SEHYOK OH exists pursuant to Business and Professions Code Sections 10177.5

II

The standard of proof applied was clear and convincing proof to a reasonable certainty.

ORDER

The license and license rights of Respondents THE STANDARD GROUP INC. and WILLIAM SEHYOK OH under the provisions of Part I of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code are revoked.
