ORDER SUSPENDING REAL ESTATE LICENSES

TO: ORACLE 4 INVESTMENTS INC. and JUDITH GALLARDO 8043 2nd Street, Suite 101 Downey, California 90241

On December 16, 2011 you entered into a Stipulation and Agreement

("Stipulation") with the Bureau that became effective February 3, 2012. Certain conditions of that Stipulation included the following:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 10148 of the Business and Professions Code, Respondents shall pay the Commissioner's reasonable cost for (a) the audit which led to this disciplinary action and (b) a subsequent audit to determine if Respondents are in compliance with the Real Estate Law.
- 2. The cost of the audit which led to this disciplinary action is \$7, 258.05. The total balance due for the original audit costs is \$7,000, as of March 19, 2013.
- 3. Respondents were to pay said amount on March 19, 2013 pursuant to a deferred payment plan with the Bureau.
- 4. If payment has not been timely made as aforesaid, or as provided in a subsequent agreement, the Commissioner may suspend Respondents' licenses.
- 5. The suspension shall remain in effect until payment is made in full or until Respondents enter into an agreement to provide for payment, or until a decision providing otherwise is adopted following a hearing.

The Commissioner has determined that as of this date, Respondents have failed to satisfy these conditions, and as such, are in violation of the terms and conditions as described above.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the real estate broker licenses of Respondents ORACLE 4 INVESTMENTS INC. and JUDITH GALLARDO are suspended until such time as Respondents provide proof satisfactory to the Bureau of compliance with the conditions referred to above, or pending final determination made after hearing (see "Hearing Rights" set forth below).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all license certificates and identification cards issued by the Bureau which are in the possession of Respondents be immediately surrendered by personal delivery or by mailing in the enclosed, self-addressed envelope to:

Hearing Rights: You have the right to a hearing to contest the Commissioner's determination that you are in violation of the Stipulation and Agreement. If you desire a hearing, you must submit a written request. The request may be in any form, as long as it is in writing and indicates that you want a hearing. Unless a written request for a hearing, signed by or on behalf of you, is delivered or mailed to the Bureau at 320 W. Fourth St., Room 350, Los Angeles, CA. 90013, within 20 days after the date that this Order was mailed to or served on you, the Bureau will not be required to furnish you a hearing.

This Order shall be effective immediately.
