ORDER GRANTING REMOVAL OF DISCIPLINE INFORMATION FROM RESPONDENT'S PUBLIC INFORMATION PAGE ON THE DEPARTMENT OF REAL ESTATE'S WEBSITE

On February 21, 2012, in Case No. H-37320 LA, a Decision was rendered disciplining the real estate broker license of Respondent effective March 29, 2012.
