DECLARATION

My name is MATTHEW SANTOLI, and I am currently licensed as a real estate broker and/or have license rights with respect to said license. I am representing myself in this matter.

In lieu of proceeding in this matter in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (Sections 11400 et seq., of the Government Code), I wish to voluntarily surrender my real estate license issued by the Department of Real Estate ("Department"), pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 10100.2.

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I understand that by so voluntarily surrendering my license, I may be relicensed as a broker or as a salesperson only by petitioning for reinstatement pursuant to Section 11522 of the Government Code. I also understand that by so voluntarily surrendering my license, I agree to the following:

- 1. The filing of this Declaration shall be deemed as my petition for voluntary surrender.
- 2. It shall also be deemed to be an understanding and agreement by me that I waive all rights I have to require the Commissioner to prove the allegations contained in the Accusation filed in this matter at a hearing held in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (Government Code Sections 11400 et seq.), and that I also waive other rights afforded to me in connection with the hearing such as the right to discovery, the right to present evidence in defense of the allegations in the Accusation and the right to cross-examine witnesses.
- 3. I further agree that upon acceptance by the Commissioner, as evidenced by an appropriate order, all affidavits and all relevant evidence obtained by the Department in this matter prior to the Commissioner's acceptance, and all allegations contained in the Accusation filed in the Department Case No. H-37414 LA, may be considered by the Department to be true and correct for the purpose of deciding whether to grant relicensure or reinstatement pursuant to Government Code Section 11522.

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I freely and voluntarily surrender all my licenses and license rights under the Real Estate Law. 5. A copy of the Commissioner's Criteria of Rehabilitation is attached hereto. If and when a petition application is made for reinstatement of a surrendered license, the Real Estate Commissioner will consider as one of the criteria of rehabilitation, whether or not restitution has been made to any person who has suffered monetary losses through "substantially related" acts or omissions of Respondent, whether or not such persons are named in the Accusation filed in this case. 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

ACCUSATION

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The Complainant, Robin Trujillo, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, for cause of Accusation against MATTHEW SANTOLI (hereinafter "Respondent"), is informed and alleges as follows:

1.

The Complainant, Robin Trujillo, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, makes this Accusation in her official capacity.

2.

At all times herein mentioned, Respondent was and still is licensed and/or has license rights under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code) as a real estate broker. Respondent was first licensed by the Department as a broker on or about October 17, 2007.

3.

On or about October 1, 2008, pursuant to order of the Commissioner of Banks,

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engaging in a residential mortgage lending business in any capacity, including a mortgage broker, exclusive mortgage broker, mortgage banker, qualifying individual, control person, managing principal, branch manager, loan officer or limited loan officer as those terms are defined under the Mortgage Lending Act of that state. The basis for Respondent's discipline involved his conduct, acts and/or omissions as managing principal for North American Real

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The discipline of Respondent's license to practice law based upon conduct, acts and/or omissions as managing principal of a corporate licensee would constitute grounds for discipline in this state, and therefore constitutes cause for the revocation or suspension of Respondent's license and/or license rights pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 10177(f).

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WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all licenses and/or license rights of Respondent, MATTHEW SANTOLI, under the Real Estate Law and for such other and further relief as may be proper under applicable provisions of law.
