ORDER EXTENDING TIME

On June 6, 2012, a Stipulation and Agreement was rendered herein. The Stipulation and Agreement, which became effective on September 4, 2012, was subject to certain limitations, conditions and restrictions, including a

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requirement that Respondents LLOYDS INVESTMENT INC and HAMID REZA LAVASSANI shall:

"within six (6) months from the effective of the Decision herein, provide proof satisfactory to the Commissioner that restitution has been paid as follows: \$3,190 to Reza Samadi and \$3,095 to Alireza Bayatoni."

The Stipulation and Agreement further ordered that, if Respondents failed to satisfy this condition, the Commissioner may order suspension of Respondents' licenses until Respondents provide proof satisfactory to the Commissioner.

On February 13, 2013, Respondents submitted a request to extend the time to complete the condition described above.

Good cause having been shown, the time during which Respondents must complete the condition described above is hereby extended to September 4, 2013.

This Order shall be effective immediately.
