18	On September 14, 2012, Respondent's license and
19	licensing rights were suspended for a period of ninety (90) days,
20	subject to the terms, conditions and restrictions set forth in
21	the Stipulation and Agreement filed August 15, 2012, in Case No.
22	H-37434 LA. This Stipulation became effective at 12 o'clock noon
23	on September 14, 2012 and provided that sixty (60) days of the
24 25	ninety (90) day suspension would be stayed for a period of two
25	(2) years upon certain terms and conditions.
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Among those terms, conditions and restrictions, the failure of which the Real Estate Commissioner may by appropriate order suspend the right to exercise any privileges granted under the restricted license is the requirement that:

IV. Respondent MICHAEL JEFFREY SIMPSON shall within six (6) Months from the effective date of the Decision herein, take and pass the Professional Responsibility Examination administered by the Department including the payment of the appropriate examination fee. If Respondent fails to satisfy this condition, the Commissioner may order suspension of Respondent MICHAEL JEFFREY SIMPSON's license until Respondent passes the examination.

The Commissioner has determined that as of March 14, 2013, Respondent has failed to satisfy this condition, and as such, is in violation of the Commissioner's Order of August 15, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED under authority of the 18 Order issued in this matter that the real estate broker license 19 20 heretofore issued to Respondent and the exercise of any 21 privileges thereunder is hereby suspended until such time as 22 Respondent provides proof satisfactory to the Department of 23 compliance with the condition referred to above, or pending final 24 determination made after hearing (see "Hearing Rights" set forth 25 below). 26 111
