On or about January 12, 2010, in the Superior Court of the State of California, County of Riverside, in Case No. SWM088147, Respondent was convicted of violating Penal Code Sections 243(e)(1) (battery on spouse or cohabitant) and 242 (battery), misdemeanors. Respondent was sentenced to 15 days in jail; 36 months probation; ordered to pay fines; ordered to perform 20 hours of community service; enroll in a 52-week domestic violence program, and refrain from annoying, harassing, threatening or disturbing the peace of the victims.

This conviction, by its facts and circumstances, bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

The crime of which Respondent was convicted constitutes cause under Sections 490 and 10177(b) of the Code for the suspension or revocation of the license and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.
