On August 28, 2009, the Department received a complaint from Maryanne Keenum Schulze against Respondent. In August, 2009, Respondent acted in the capacity of an agent for Ms. Schulze in the sale of real property located in Irvine, California. Respondent forged Ms. Schulze's signature on a Seller's Estimated Net Proceeds form without Ms. Schulze's knowledge. Respondent earned a substantial commission upon the close of escrow for the sale of the subject property.

The facts set forth above are grounds for the suspension or revocation of Respondent's real estate salesperson license and license rights under Code Section 10176(a) for substantial misrepresentation, Code Section 10176(i) for conduct which constitutes fraud or dishonest dealing and/or Code Section 10177(g) for negligence.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against the license and/or license rights of Respondent NATALIE CAROL BENJAMIN under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code) and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
