estate broker.

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On or about February 6, 2009, in the Superior Court of the State of California, County of Los Angeles, in Case No. 7PS60343, Respondent was convicted of violating Vehicle Code Section 14601.1(a) (driving while privilege suspended or 5 revoked), a misdemeanor. Respondent was sentenced to 36 months 6 probation, ordered to perform 57 hours of community service, and 7 ordered to pay fines.

In aggravation, on or about April 7, 2008, in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, in Case No. 8PK02100, Respondent was convicted of violating Vehicle Code Sections 14601.1.1(a) (driving while privilege suspended or revoked) and 14601.3(A) (habitual traffic offender), a misdemeanor, based on these prior convictions for violation of Vehicle Code Section 14601.1:

- Pomona Court, Case No. 703444 8/6/07 2)
- 4/10/07 Alhambra Court, Case No. 604832 3)

- 1/20/06 Pomona Court, Case No. 507622 5) Respondent was sentenced to three years probation, 150 days in jail, and ordered to pay fines.

The conviction described in Paragraph 3, by its facts and circumstances, bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of

Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee. 6. The crime of which Respondent was convicted, as described in Paragraph 3, constitutes cause under Sections 490 and 10177(b) of the Code for the suspension or revocation of the license and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law. 1.0 /// /// 111: /// ///
